
SUBJECT: **DIRECTIVE No. 001-05-03-13 (AWG16GM)**

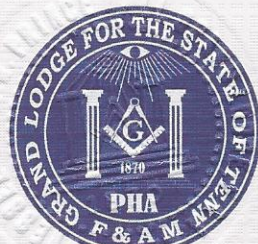
Be it known unto you, that ALL Subordinate Prince Hall Lodges within the Jurisdiction of Tennessee are instruments of the Most Worshipful Prince Hall Grand Lodge F. & A.M. of Tennessee, operating under a Charter or Dispensation issued by this Grand Body empowering it to work. No Lodge within the Prince Hall Jurisdiction is independent of the Grand Lodge, independent of the Region or independent of the District within which it is located and WILL NOT be allowed to operate as such.

In the spirit of promoting Unity, Growth and Harmony at every level within the Prince Hall Jurisdiction of Tennessee; I issue the following **DIRECTIVE**:


I **DIRECT ALL** Subordinate Lodges, to exercise due diligence in following the directives issued from the District Deputy Grand Master and the instructions issued by the Grand Lecturer as well as the District Lecturers. I also **DIRECT** each and every Lodge to take an active part in the planning and organization of its District events to include participation in designated Masonic Must days, i.e., Prince Hall Americanism Day, St. Johns Day, Grand Master's Visitation, etc.

No Lodge is exempt and the Officers of any Lodge failing to comply will be subject to charges of contumacy or insubordination.
